Topic: RECREATIONAL PROPERTY TAX REBATE POLICY

Policy Statement:

1. All persons owning Recreational Real Property in the municipality may be eligible for a full rebate on those seasonal residences that are accessible only by boat, snowmobile, ATV, etc. The rebate would be available on a yearly basis and must be applied for annually.
2. The following criteria must be met:
 - An application must be completed each year
 - The applicant must be in good standing on all properties owned by the applicant
 - The recreational property must not be the applicants principal residence
 - The recreational property must not be connected into municipal water and sewer services
 - The recreational property must not be connected into local hydro utilities
 - The recreational property must not have year round access by public road
 - The recreational property owner must provide a photograph of the property
