Qualifications:

- ✓ Current BCLS certification is required;
- ✓ Current ACLS, PALS, TNCC certification or willingness to complete in one year.

- ✓ A valid Newfoundland and Labrador Class 5 Drivers license
- ✓ The successful applicant will be required to submit a satisfactory certificate of conduct.

Duties: (Included but not limited to)

- ✓ Primarily responsible for the delivery of primary health care and chronic disease management;
- ✓ Independently and collaboratively assesses, diagnoses, and prescribes in accordance with professional, provincial, and organizational standards, policies and clinical practice guidelines;
- ✓ Utilizing a Person and family Centered care approach works within a collaborative care team to ensure optimal care;
- ✓ Advocates for clients, assessing their needs and if applicable, referring to appropriate care providers, professionals, or other services in the interest of the continuum of care;
