Road Grant, \$1000.00

- l. We the herewith attached do humbly petition the Department of Public Works for the sum of \$1000.00 for the purpose of building a road from Hamilton River Settlement to the main road of Goose Airport, which is a distance of about three miles.
- 2. The said road is our only means of transportation to and from our work at Goose Airport, and the only means of transportation from this settlement to Hospital Facilities. These facilities are urgently needed as about three hundred people live in this settlement.
- 3. We have collected about one third of the estimated cost to build the said road. The United States Engineers Dept. have agreed to loan us some equipment to do the job.
- 4. Wishing to be obliged and that this will meet with your approval, we remain your humble petitioners.

PUELIC FCTICE

REGULATIONS PERCYCLING TO WEST DAMPS OF THE TUPLLITON TOVER SETTLEMENT.

- 1. The Hamilton River Settlement is situated within the boundaries of the property leased to the Dominion Covernment of Canada, the local representative being the RCFF. The islands adjacent to this property are considered mart and percel of the settlement and the local regulations listed are applicable to residents living on these islands.
- The local administration of the Settlement is to be administered by a committee which is to be elected at an annual public meeting. This Committee is to be known as the Hamilton River Liaison Committee and one of its members is to be appointed Chairman and another Secretary Treasurer. The purpose of the Committee will be to assist with the local administration of the community and to make recommendations to the RCAF for:

 - (a) Local Improvements
 - (b) Resident Permits

- (c) Eviction of Undesimbles
- (d) Welfare Latters
- 3. The Committee will meet regularly and a monthly meeting is to be held with the RCAF representatives and local government and welfare agencies to determine and decide policy.

- 4. The RCAF Committee will consist of the Corrarding Officer, Chief Administrative Officer, Senior Medical Officer, Chief Technical Officer, Protestant Chaplain, Provest Marshal and the Newfoundland Magistrate and Welfare Officer will be invited to attend these meetings.
- 5. All matters pertaining to welfare, namely Family Allowances, Dependents' Allowances and other grants are to be submitted to the Newfoundland Melfare Officer. All medical matters are to be referred to Dr. Paddon of the Granfell Mission who will be responsible for the administration of the new hospital and dispensary to be erected in the community.
- 6. Sub-Cormittees may be formed to the Liaison Committee and it is suggested that they be formed to look after church affairs, school affairs and sanitary matters. These sub-committees will be subsidiary to and report to the Liaison Committee.

Tegulations

- 7. Where applicable the RC # Station Standing Orders will be in offect.
- 8. Fersons desiring to maintain residence in the Hamilton River Settlement are subject to the following provisions:
 - (a) They must be a Newfoundland Mational.
 - (b) They must be employed permanently by either the RCAF, USAF, or DOT.
 - (c) Their application to obtain and build , on a plot pust be recomended by the Liaison Committee.
 - (d) The application to the RCAF for authority to occupy and build on a plot must contain the following information:
 - (i) Plan of the House
 - (ii) Sanitary Arrangements
 - (1:i) Availability of material to build the house.

- (e) The final authority to occupy or build is to be approved by the RCAF Administration.
- 9. In any case where the Liaison Committee recommend that a resident is undesirable and hence not wanted in the community, full particulars are to be submitted to the RCAF Administration and the Magistrate will be requested to proceed with an eviction notice which will borserved on the individual and they will be required to leave the settlement on the first available transportation.
- 10. The settlement is Out of Bounds to all RCAF and USAF Military Personnel and itinerant and transient civilians. Trespassers will be subject to arrest by either the Provost or RCEP.
